We have reached a decision regarding your submission entitled "Analysis of Earthquake Hazards Prediction with Multivariate Adaptive Regression Splines" to International Journal of Electrical and Computer Engineering (IJECE)", a Scopus indexed journal, Scimago journal ranking (SJR) Q2.

Our decision is to: REJECT and submit elsewhere, due to one or more of the below reasons:

- Substantial contribution and/or presentation of paper is not suitable for a Scopus indexed journal (SJR Q2)
- Quality of references is not suitable
- Figures or Tables are not cited properly in the text
- Quality of figures is poor
- Figures or Tables do not include relevant titles, captions and description in English.
- Each citation is not written in the order of appearance in the text. Citations and references are not sequential (All references mentioned in the Reference List are NOT cited in the text, and vice versa).
- Authors do not adhere to the style requirements as outlined in the guideline for authors
- Authors do not comply requirements for publication within the time-frame, even after extra time, example: Authors do not preparing final camera-ready paper properly and do not pay publication fee within the time frame.
- Manuscript has high similarity rate (high potential plagiarism)
- Authors failed to submit revised papers within the allotted time
- Other reasons.

A good research paper has a clear statement of the problem the paper is addressing, the proposed solution(s), and results achieved. It describes clearly what has been done before on the problem, and what is new.

IMPORTANT

1. Introduction section: explain the context of the study and state the precise objective. An Introduction should contain the following three (3) parts:

- Background: Authors have to make clear what the context is. Ideally, authors should give an idea of the state-of-the art of the field the report is about.

- The Problem: If there was no problem, there would be no reason for writing a manuscript, and definitely no reason for reading it. So, please tell readers why they should proceed reading. Experience shows that for this part a few lines are often sufficient.

- The Proposed Solution: Now and only now! - authors may outline the contribution of the manuscript. Here authors have to make sure readers point out what are the novel aspects of authors work.

Authors should place the paper in proper context by citing relevant papers. At least, 5 references (recently journal articles) are used in this section.

2. Method section: the presentation of the experimental methods should be clear and complete in every detail facilitating reproducibility by other scientists.

3. Results and discussion section: The presentation of results should be simple and straightforward in style. This section report the most important findings, including results of statistical analyses as appropriate and comparisons to other research results. This is where the author(s) should explain in words what he/she/they discovered in the research. It should be clearly laid out and in a logical sequence. Discussion should be supported suitable references. You should improve your analyzing and present comparison of your results to those obtained in similar studies. The "result and discussion" section reports the most important findings, including analysing results as appropriate. It is very important to prove that your manuscript has a significant value and not trivial.

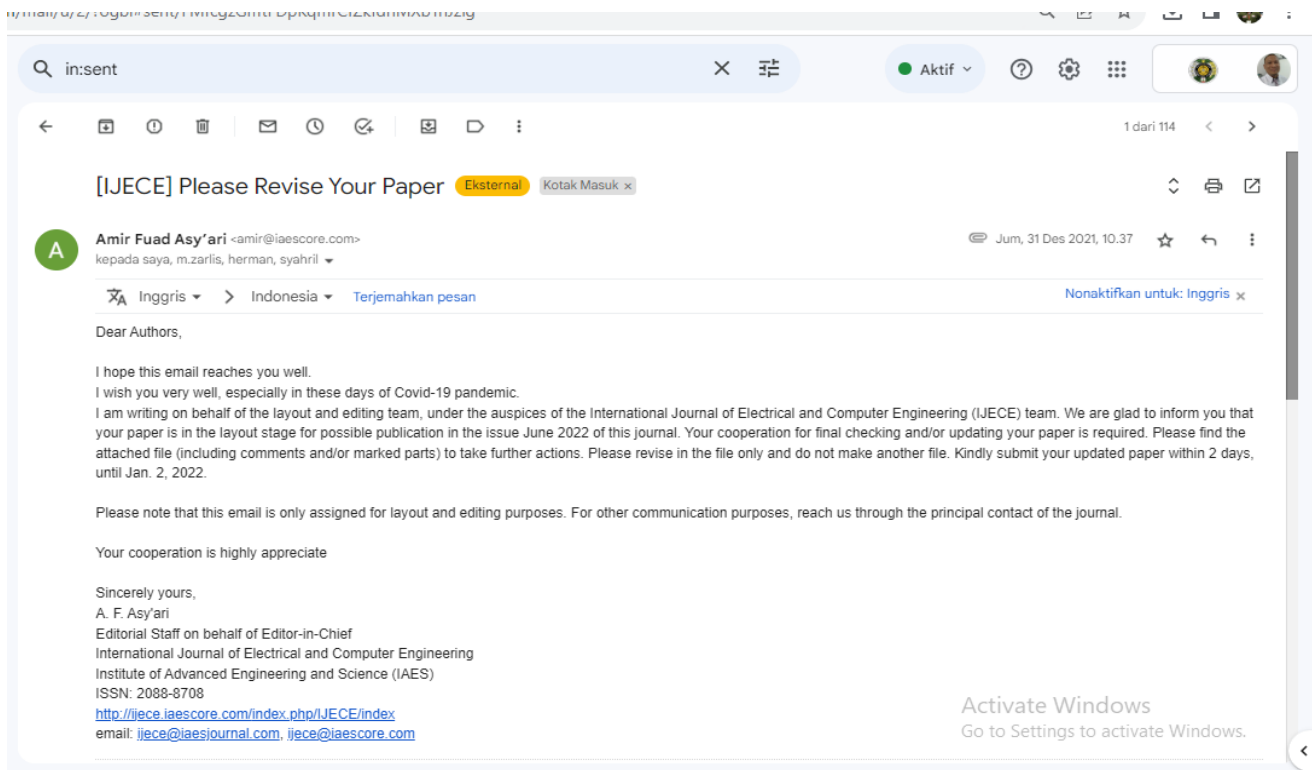
